Rising and Falling is an examination of footage taken within the vicinity of the Borthwick Water, filmed between 2014 and 2017. The Borthwick Water runs from Craik Forest, through Robertson in The Borthwick valley, and meets the Teviothead, before it runs into Hawick. The film explores themes of home and safety, transience, reflections and repetition through a personal connection and a sense of place. The accompanying zine shares selected thoughts, notes and diaries from the days the footage was taken.

Jessie Growden started making films in 2014 as part of an Alchemy film & Arts initiative, and is a founding member of the Scottish Borders based Moving Image Makers Collective. Her films explore place and landscape through a playful approach with small cameras placed to experience moments.
